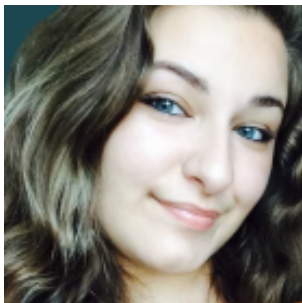

Our Team 2021-22

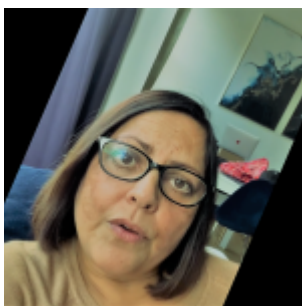
believe in fairness, justice, equality and recognise everyone as unique.

Society lead, I hope to add value and support you all with enthusiasm and a little bit of humour.

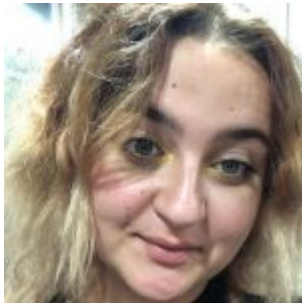
Johana Petit Frere- Business Society Leader
